## NOTICE OF RACE

**1. LOCATION** University of South Florida Haney Landing Sailing Center, St. Petersburg Campus, next to the FL Marine Research Institute, 1st street and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE. Please do not park in the Florida Marine Research Institute lot. You may park on the street (Refer to: <http://www1.stpt.usf.edu/aboutusf/map>). Metered spots on the street are \$.50 per hour, but have a 3-hour limit.

**2. CLASSES** Twelve FJs and operating equipment will be provided. FJs will be rotated (conditions permitting) among competitors to assure equality of equipment. Personal safety equipment including US Coast Guard Type III PFDs and other gear (e.g., cold weather) must be furnished by the competitors. Bailers will not be provided.

**3. ELIGIBILITY** All new 2008-09 Member Schools of the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) and those that have not qualified for the Mallory or Baker Regatta in the last 4 years, 8<sup>th</sup> grade and up... *OR Any School New to SAISA is ELIGIBLE!*

**The following schools are not eligible due to qualification for the ISSA Mallory or Baker Regattas in the March-Q series:**

*Antilles School (05/06/07/08), H. B. Plant High (05/06/07/08), Lakewood High (05/06/07/08), Martin County High (05), Pine View School (05/07), James Island Charter (08), Sarasota (08), St. Thomas Aquinas (08).*

Competitors on a team must attend the same school they represent full time and must be in the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade as of the date of the Regatta. *Two or more sailors from the same school will make up the team.*

**Registration for the event should be received by SAISA no later than Monday, Oct. 6th.**

*Registration is on a first paid/first allowed basis.* Registration will be limited to 24 school teams, one team per school.

The regatta will serve as both the District Great Oaks Championship & qualification for the National ISSA Great Oaks Invitational Regatta in New Orleans Nov. 15-16, 2008. All teams must be registered with entry **fees paid by COB, 6 October**. There will be no late registration at the USF regatta site. (Note that if qualifying, the school team for the ISSA National Invitational event will be composed of 2 & a maximum of 4 sailors.)

**A responsible adult is required to accompany each team and be responsible for the school's team including their conduct on and off the water. The responsible adult is expected to have full authority to obtain medical treatment for his/her team members.**

**4. ENTRY FEE & DAMAGE DEPOSIT** There will be an entry fee of \$40.00, plus a boat damage deposit of \$100.00.

**NOTE: All participating school teams must pre-register for this event.**

Damage deposits: Each team is expected to accept full financial responsibility if they cause damage or loss to the boats and equipment used in this regatta. Damage that requires more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the jury determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage, one or both boats may be held financially responsible &/or disqualified regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. If the jury is unable to assess a particular team, deposits will be pooled and used to pay for damage and loss. The findings will be final and not subject to appeal in this regard. *Unused deposits will be voided within 3 weeks of the last race.*

**6. AWARDS & QUALIFICATION FOR NATIONAL EVENT** Trophies will be awarded to the top 6 qualifying school teams. It is intended that 6 double-handed teams from within the South Atlantic District will be eligible to participate in the ISSA Great Oaks Invitational Regatta. The exact number of qualifying school teams from SAISA will be confirmed in the near future.

Following qualification, if notification is not received on or before 20 October by SAISA that the qualifying team can attend the National event, an alternate team will be invited.

Following notification to SAISA, the qualifying teams must then submit check and all forms to the G. O. Registrar in New Orleans or the berth will be lost to another district.

**7. AUTHORITY** This regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules, *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. Advertising will be restricted to Category A. An official bulletin board will be maintained at the sailing center for changes to this notice, the race instructions, etc. It is the skipper's responsibility to check the board for changes.

**8. FORMAT** This will be a one-division regatta with single A-division sailing – *minimum 2 sailors per school form a team*; teams will rotate through the boat (other sailors may be substituted at this time) per a rotation posted on the day of the event. The number of races in a series will be equal to the number of teams competing in the regatta. Time permitting; the Race Committee will attempt to run a multiple series of races. All races will be scored regardless of whether the series was completed. Three races will constitute a regatta. All coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment or sustenance shall be provided only on shore or on a designated vessel on the water. Competitors should expect numerous short races with boat rotations as set forth at the skipper's meeting. Two or more sailors will compose the school's team.

If more than 14 schools register, racing on Saturday will be divided into two divisions, with the goal of completing one full rotation per division. The top six schools from each division will then advance to a championship series, with prior qualifying scores being discarded.

**9. SCORING** Low point system for individual races as modified by ISSA Rule 9. Ties will be resolved per procedural rule 11(c).

**10. LUNCH** No lunches, food, or drinks will be provided. Plan to be on the water all day so bring plenty of food and water with you in the morning.
