

**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**INLAND NORTH POINTS 6 SAISA REGATTA**  
**November 17th, 2007**

**HOST: Atlanta Area High School Sailing & LLSC Jr. Program & GA Tech**  
**SITE: Lake Lanier Sailing Club; Flowery Branch, GA.**

**1. RULES**

This regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules, SAISA Supplemental Rules, *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

**2. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

Saturday November 17

08:30 Arrival and check-in, boat rigging

09:00 Competitors' Meeting

10:00 Start of first race of day

**3. FORMAT**

This will be a two-division regatta; teams will rotate through the boats per a rotation posted on the day of the event. Competitors should expect numerous short races with boat rotations as set forth at the skippers meeting. It will be the goal of the race committee to complete one full round robin rotation of boats. Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a regatta. All coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment or sustenance shall be on shore.

**4. SCORING**

Low point system for individual races as modified by ISSA Rule 9. Ties will be resolved per procedural rule 11 (c). Points will be award to Inland Area Teams to qualify for participation in the North Points Gold and the North Points Silver regattas. The Gold Regatta will qualify teams for the SAISA District Championship and the District Championship for the ISSA Mallory Trophy Regatta.

**5. AWARDS & TROPHIES**

Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race to be sailed in the event.

**6. ELIGIBILITY**

All 2007-08 member schools of the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) are eligible. This regatta is a North Points Inland Area regatta. All schools must be in members in good standing with SAISA. A school may pay SAISA Dues at check in.

Competitors must attend the school they represent full time and must be in the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, as of the date of the Regatta. If your school does not have sufficient sailors to form the necessary teams, we will attempt to "mix and match" sailors from different member schools.

An adult team representative is required to accompany each team and be responsible for their conduct on and off the water. The team representative, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent, is expected to have full authority to obtain medical treatment for his/her team members.

A JV Team for an eligible school may be entered when pre-approved by SAISA. For JV Team Approval, contact Tom Monkus at (727) 821-9080. Each JV Team may be responsible for providing their own 420, as preference will be given to schools with only one team.

**7. FEES& REGISTRATION**

The entry fee shall be \$30.00 per school team, paid in advance by using the Regatta [Registration](#) and [Waiver](#) forms available on the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association website ([www.saisa.org](http://www.saisa.org)) under "General Forms - [Samples](#)". Checks, registration form, waivers, and the number of lunches needed should be mailed to: Martine Zurinkas 8070 Willow Tree Way, Alpharetta, GA 30005

Registration will be accepted first from North Points Inland area teams whose registration is received by **Friday, November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2007**; availability will be considered in the order that registrations are received. All other registrations will be considered in the order they are received. All registration must be received by **Tuesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2007**. Once 12 schools have registered, each additional school seeking registration will be notified that their entry will be contingent upon their ability to bring their own 420 sailboat in good racing condition to add to the rotation.

**8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in at Lake Lanier Sailing Club clubhouse (LLSC).

**9. BOATS**

Club 420s will be used, and Lake Lanier Sailing Club Juniors and Georgia Tech Sailing will provide 12 boats. Personal safety equipment including US Guard Type III PFDs must be worn by the competitors.

**10. RACING AREA**

The racing will be on Lake Lanier out of the Lake Lanier Sailing Club.

**11. DAMAGE**

Damage that requires more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Protest Committee determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage one or both boats may be disqualified regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, either or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and held financially responsible for the damages.

**12. FOOD**

Lunches are available for \$5.00 per person. Reservations for lunches **must be made** with registration to guarantee availability. Water & Lemonade & Hot Chocolate will be provided during the day.
