1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules and SAISA Supplementary Rules, The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, this Notice of Race (except as changed by the sailing instructions), and the Sailing Instructions.

2. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Saturday October 23, 2010:

0830 Arrival and check-in, boat rigging

0930 Competitors Meeting

1015 Start of first race of the day

Sunday October 24, 2010: Only if racing is necessary to constitute a "fair" regatta

0900 Competitor's meeting

0945 Start of the first race

1400 No race to be started after this time

3. FORMAT

This will be a two-division regatta; teams will rotate through the boats per a rotation posted on the day of the event. A Sound Signal Starting System shall be used. Competitors should expect numerous short races with boat rotations as set forth at the skipper's meeting. It shall be the goal of the race committee to complete one full round robin rotation of boats. Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a "fair" regatta. All coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment or sustenance shall be provided only on shore or on a designated vessel on the water.

4. SCORING

4.1 Low point system for individual races as modified by ISSA Rule 9. Ties will be resolved per procedural rule 11(c).

Note that when the school "team" is composed of two (2) or more sailors from different schools the composite team sailor's schools will be indicated on the results. Minimally the 1st – 3rd divisional & top three (3) places will indicate the names of the sailors on the race results. Race highlights with results will be forwarded to SAISA for processing and points will be awarded to qualify for participation in the District Championship (qualifier for the ISSA Mallory Trophy regatta).

4.2 Protests hearings, if any, may take place between races. We will attempt to post preliminary results in real time between races.

5. AWARDS & TROPHIES

Prizes may be awarded after completion of the last race with results to follow.

6. FEES

The entry fee shall be \$35.00 per each school team, paid in advance by using the [registration](#) and [waiver](#) forms available on the SAISA website (www.saisa.org). Checks should be made payable to Lake Eustis Youth Sailing Foundation and mailed to: Leah Ladley, Treasurer LEYSF, 37918 C.R. 44A North, Eustis, FL 32736 along with the signed [Registration](#) and [Waiver](#) Forms. Please make sure that your email address is legible on the registration form.

7. ELIGIBILITY

7.1 All 2010-11 member teams of the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) are welcome. The regatta is a South Points Regatta. Points will be awarded to qualify for participation in the Mallory District Championship and Qualifier for ISSA fleet racing nationals, within the South Atlantic District.

7.2 All schools must be members in good standing with SAISA. If a school wishes to participate, and has not yet paid the ISSA/SAISA dues, they will be provided the opportunity to pay dues at check-in however the team must be preregistered with ISSA/SAISA online with a "preliminary" membership classification. *If a North Point school wishes to participate, they may be required to provide their own 420. The NP school may be scored in place similar to a JV team.*

7.3 Registration is on a first paid/first allowed basis. Once **5 (five)** schools have registered, each school will be notified by the venue that their entry shall be contingent upon their ability to bring their own 420 sailboat to add to the rotation. Registration will be confirmed by the venue via e-mail, or phone, if e-mail is not available.

7.4 Competitors must attend the school they represent full time and must be in the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, as of the date of the Regatta. If your school does not have sufficient sailors to form the necessary teams, we will attempt to "mix and match" sailors from different registered teams.

7.5 An adult school representative/advisor is required to accompany each team and be responsible for their conduct on and off the water. The team representative, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent, is expected to have full authority to obtain medical treatment for his team members.

7.6 Eligible SAISA teams may enter both varsity and one JV team (if the team membership is at 12 or more sailors); however only the varsity team score will be used to determine Championship Points. A JV team may also be entered only when pre-approved by SAISA. For JV team approval, contact Tom Monkus at (727) 821-9080. Boat priority will be given to non-JV teams.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available upon check-in.

9. BOATS

Club 420's will be used and 5 (five) will be provided by the venue. Priority for boats will be given to South Point teams. Personal safety equipment including US Coast Guard Type III PFDs must be furnished by the competitors. Bailers will not be provided.

10. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on Lake Eustis. Racecourse location will be announced at Competitors meeting.

11. LUNCHES

Plan to bring your own lunch. There are several restaurants nearby that have take-out. Water bottles will be provided.

12. DAMAGE

Damage that requires more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Regatta Chairman determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage one or both boats may be disqualified regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, the skipper and crew of either or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and held financially responsible for the damages.

The Lake Eustis Sailing Club is located on the East shore of Lake Eustis at **1310 Country Road 452, Eustis, FL 32736**. **Directions: Just north of downtown Eustis, 19 North 'forks' at a traffic light by the Exxon filling station into 19 North and CR 452: Go left onto C.R. 452; second road to the left is the Lake Eustis Sailing Club Drive.** Check for map and directions at our website at www.Lakeeustisailingclub.org.
